- All sales need to have pre-approval. Note pre-approval doesn't mean asking that morning, not that I ever did that :) but let's just learn from experience. To receive approval please submit a short note stating what you are selling, who you are raising money for, how you are involved with the group that you are selling for and how you plan to handle the division of sales if there are others in the group selling the same thing as well as how you plan to find out if there are others in the group selling the same thing. Also, if there is a start date and end date for you sale, indicate that as well so that we make sure you get scheduled while the sale is actually happening.

- We are a homeschool group and while no one in this group would ever sell anything offensive intentionally, be sure that what you are promoting is family / homeschool friendly.
